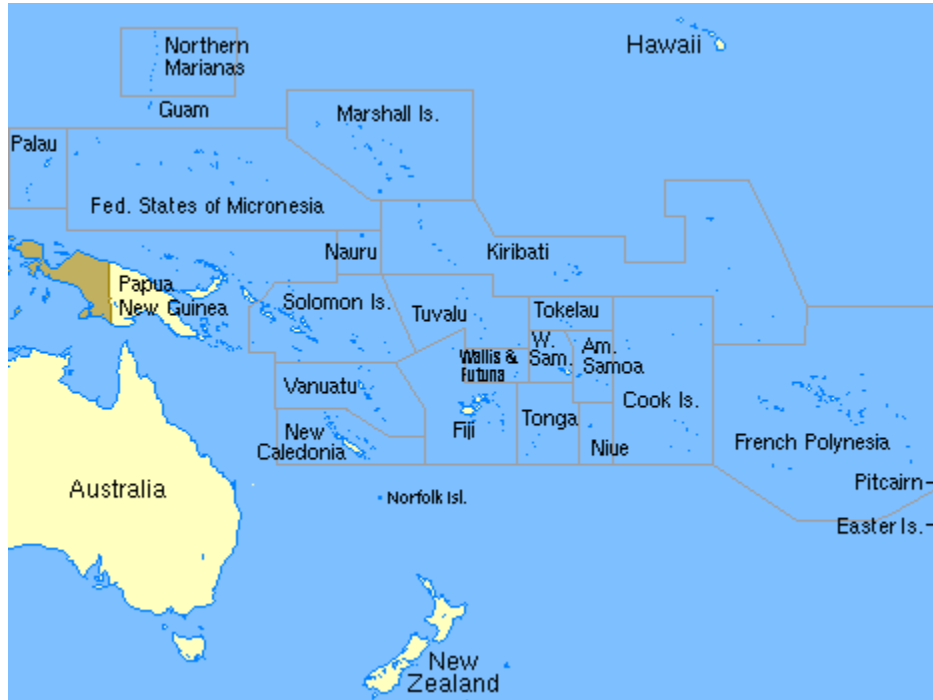

G'day! Welcome to Sydney

After completing arrival formalities and collecting your luggage, please make your way to the arrivals area where you will be met by your local representative and assisted by your private coach. Enjoy an introduction to Sydney, one of the most beautiful cities in the World and the most cosmopolitan city in Australia. It is endowed with a sparkling harbour, fabulous beaches, and a sunny Mediterranean climate. Depart Sydney Airport by private coach and head to the Gap on the ocean headland at Watsons Bay before continuing onto the iconic Bondi Beach and see the surfers and locals enjoying the laidback Sydney lifestyle. Here you can enjoy some free time taking a walk along the coast and have lunch. Later, reboard the coach and travel to the city passing some of the historical buildings of Macquarie Street, Parliament House, The Mint and Hyde Park Barracks including a visit to Mrs. Macquarie's Chair a sandstone rock cut into the shape of a bench, on a peninsula in Sydney Harbour. Here you will have a breathtaking view of the city and harbour with perfect photo opportunities before arriving at the hotel.

Day 04 - Saturday, Mar.15/2025 – Sydney / Full Day Blue Mountains Tour

After an early breakfast, meet your local guide at the hotel and travel by private coach through Sydney's inner Western Suburbs to Featherdale Wildlife Park one of Australia's largest private collections of Australian animals for a memorable and unique experience in a natural and well-established bush setting. Next, we continue the journey following the trail of Australia's early explorers as the coach ascends into the Blue Mountains National Park. Travel through the historic townships of Blaxland, Springwood, Lawson and Wentworth Falls and view the National Trust township of Leura. The Blue Mountains are aptly named because of the blue haze caused by rays of light striking dust particles and small droplets

of moisture in the atmosphere. The haze is an interesting scientific phenomenon, noticeable because of the heavy timbering of Eucalypt trees in the area. Drive along Cliff Drive to Echo Point to view the world famous "Three Sisters". Learn fascinating Aboriginal legends, including The Mountain Devils, The Banksiamen, The Bunyip and The Witch Doctor while enjoying panoramic views of the Jamison Valley. Lunch is included during the tour (beverages own expense). After lunch, we visit Scenic World renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains Adventure – from native birds to fresh air, to breathtaking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, Katoomba Falls & Jamison Valley. Here you will have the opportunity to experience on the steepest short scenic Railway in the world, Skyway to discover the tranquility of ancient rainforest whilst strolling along the 2.4-kilometre Scenic Walkway or the Cableway and walkway to view panoramic views of the World Heritage-listed Blue Mountains from the Cableway. At the end of the activities reboard your coach for the journey back to Sydney.

Day 05 - Sunday, Mar.16/2025 – Sydney / Northern Beaches & City and Opera house tours

After breakfast at the hotel, meet your local guide who will accompany you today. Private transfer to the Rocks Area for a short, guided walk through the birthplace of modern Sydney. With the arrival of European settlers in 1788, it was here that the convicts first set up houses and shops.

Discover the area's rich colonial history as well as its contemporary position as a thriving entertainment precinct right by the spectacular Sydney Harbour. Enjoy free time to explore the markets that are held every Saturday and Sunday. You will be

surrounded by color and movement from the wide variety of stalls, here you will be tempted by the smells of the food stalls and be entertained by the talented street performers who wander the streets to share their music and performances. Opportunity to have an early lunch (own expense) before walking around to the Opera House for a guided walking tour. The walking tour offers the opportunity to experience the Sydney Opera House in its daily operation. You will be guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognisable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century. Joern Utzon, the Danish architect who designed the Opera House, ascribed the inspiration for his masterpiece to the sails of yachts on the harbour. As the Opera House is a performing arts centre, some areas may be restricted for viewing due to rehearsals and performances. Later step on the Captain Cook Premium Harbour Experience Cruise departing from Circular Quay. This is sightseeing as you've never experienced before. It's a glass of sparkling by the sails of the Sydney Opera House. A macchiato under the Harbour Bridge. A delicious Australian Cheese and Charcuterie Board to share. All savored as you relax in style, cruising Sydney Harbour in the comfort of your reserved Ocean Deck lounge seating, marveling at the sights of stunning Sydney. At the end of the harbour cruise, board your coach for the transfer back to the hotel. At the end of the tour, board your coach for the transfer back to the hotel.

After breakfast and check out – Transferred to Sydney Airport. for our flight to Cairns, on arrival in Cairns, please make your way to the luggage collection area where you will

be met by our local representative and transferred to your hotel. Cairns, the heart of Far North Queensland, is an attractive tropical city, 1,800 km north of Brisbane. It serves as a gateway to a lush, scenic hinterland and is the centre for access to the Great Barrier Reef. North and south of the city there are extensive sugar cane farms, with the Atherton Tableland nearby to the west offering everything from virgin rainforest to extinct volcanic lakes, waterfalls, gorges, and rich red farmlands. Meet & greet by local guide and assisted from Cairns Airport to the hotel.

Day 07 - Tuesday, Mar.18/2025 – Cairns / Full Day Quicksilver Outer Reef Cruise

After an early breakfast, you will be collected by a Quicksilver Coach, enjoy one of the most scenic coastal drives in Australia along the Captain Cook Highway to Port Douglas where we will you will board your cruise. Quicksilver's friendly crew will take you to Agincourt Reef at the very edge of Australia's Continental Shelf, to an underwater world that is a dazzling kaleidoscope of colour and brilliance. Here you can experience first-hand the magic of the Great Barrier Reef. You can choose to dive, snorkel, or stay dry and explore the stunning reef from the comfort of a Quicksilver semi-sub, just one meter underwater (please note diving is an extra cost). Watch the fish feeding from the unique underwater viewing platform and underwater observatory. Complimentary morning and afternoon tea and a delicious lunch are included (Beverages at own expense). There will be a Marine Biologist presentation shown on the vessel televisions as well as a snorkeling demonstration. Arrive back at Marina Mirage at approximately 4.30pm and join your coach for the transfer back to your hotel. Arrival after 6.00 PM – rest of the evening is at your own leisure.

Day 08 - Wednesday, Mar.19/2025 – Cairns / Full Day Kuranda Tour

This morning, depart the hotel by private coach accompanied by your local guide for the day. We start the tour with a coach transfer to Freshwater Station to board the historic Kuranda Rail for one of the most spectacular rail journeys in Australia. Travelling slowly, it winds its way up the epic pioneer track with every turn revealing a new panorama - sugar plantations, Barron Falls, Stoney Creek Falls for 90 minutes until it reaches Kuranda Station, a cool, tropical environment of native shrubs, ferns, and flowers. Upon

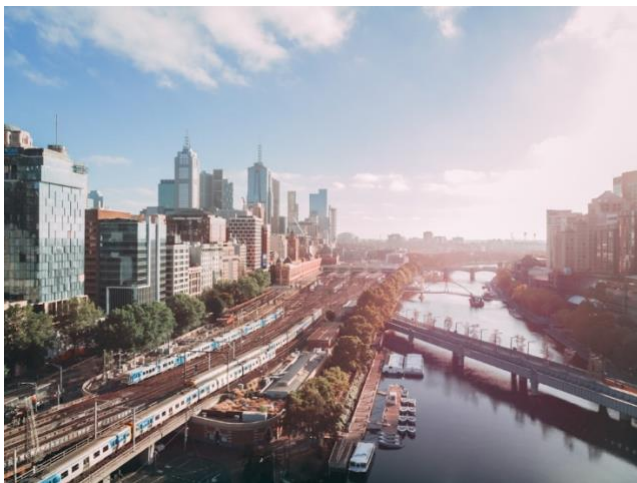
reaching Kuranda, you will have some brief time to enjoy the old-world charm of this small village before re-boarding the coach for the transfer to Rainforestation. Rainforestation is a Nature Park boasting 40 hectares of gardens and rainforest set amidst World Heritage areas. Ride the amphibious army duck through the rainforest and visit the Koala and Wildlife Park. The Dreamtime Walk provides a comprehensive introduction to Aboriginal and Islander culture and history with practical experiences including boomerang lessons on spear throwing. Witness the dynamic performance of the Pamagirri Aboriginal Dancers in the natural Amphitheatre where the rainforest serves as the theatre walls and the sounds of the forest, and the didgeridoo create the backing music. A lunch will be served during the visit. At the end of the activities, reboard your coach for a return transfer to Kuranda. Board the Skyrail Rainforest Cableway for an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep into the forest. The Skyrail experience, spanning 7.5kms over pristine rainforest, allows you to explore the wonders of an ancient tropical rainforest and learn about one of the most botanically fascinating and diverse areas on earth. Gliding just meters above the rainforest canopy in comfortable six-person gondola cabins, the Sky rail journey immerses you in an intimate rainforest experience where you'll see, hear, smell, and become part of the tropical rainforest environment. The overall Sky rail journey takes approximately 45 minutes (with no stopping) however there are 2 stops along the way where you can take a walk around the boardwalk. Allowing for the 2 stops the journey will take 1 & ½ hours. At the end of the journey re-board your coach for the transfer back to the hotel.

Explore the cosmopolitan city with wide boulevards and fine historic buildings View Bourke Street Mall and the tree-lined beauty of Collins Street - the ultimate shopping strip and business centre View fine examples of Melbourne's architectural splendor, including St. Paul's Cathedral, Princess and Regent Theatres.

Day 10 - Friday, Mar. 21/2025

After breakfast, meet your local guide who will accompany you on today's tour. Get a great overview of your tour, a discovery of Melbourne's past and present. We start the tour with a visit to one of Melbourne's most iconic destinations, Brighton

Beach mainly because of the distinctive row of Victorian-era colourful bathing boxes. Here, enjoy some free time to stroll along the boardwalk before we continue back to the city. Enjoy free time at the popular Queen Victoria Markets, an authentic, bustling, inner-city market that has been the heart and soul of Melbourne for over 140 years. Home to over 600 businesses, it is a great place to discover fresh and specialty produce, hand-made and unique products, great coffee, food, souvenirs and clothing. You may like to take the opportunity to purchase lunch (own expense) during the visit. Later, reboard your coach and continue travelling central business district with its eclectic architecture, past the 170 million dollar Victorian Arts

Centre and on to fashionable Toorak with its luxurious homes. See Captain Cook's Cottage (entry not included) in the beautiful Fitzroy Gardens with avenues of huge English elms planted along gently contoured lawns. Pass by the Botanical Gardens and

observe the hustle and bustle. Take in views of Shrine of Remembrance and ST Patrick's Cathedral. The tour will end at the hotel approx. 2.00 PM.

Meet your driver on arrival at Queenstown Airport and start the orientation tour includes a visit to Arrowtown, Kawarau bungy bridge, and Lake Wakatipu.

QUEENSTOWN/TAHUNA - is the South Island's most popular resort, set alongside the shores of Lake Wakatipu, under the gaze of the Remarkable Ranges. See the contrast of smooth glacier rounded hills, and jagged mountain summits that reach high above the ancient ice floor. The town is renowned for its jet boating, bungy-jumping, skiing, and awe-inspiring scenery. Local story has it, that the gold prospectors of the 19th century pronounced the town as "fit for any Queen", and so she was called.

Day 12 - Sunday, Mar. 23/2025 - Queenstown - Milford Sound - Queenstown

Transfer to Manapouri to your Doubtful Sound Cruise.

Real New Zealand Doubtful Sound - Wilderness Cruise - ex Manapouri

Depart from Pearl Harbour, Manapouri, and cruise across picturesque Lake Manapouri to West Arm.

Travel by coach over Wilmot Pass, through dense rainforest. Once at Doubtful Sound, board the Patea Explorer, for a 3-hour cruise of beautiful Doubtful Sound, to the Tasman Sea. There is excellent viewing of waterfalls, rainforest, and mountains. Of particular interest, if sighted, are fur seals basking on the rocks, or a resident pod of bottlenose dolphins. The rare Fiordland crested penguins are sometimes encountered, depending on the season. Return to Manapouri at the end of your journey.

Meet your driver today in the hotel lobby and transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to Rotorua. On arrival at Rotorua Airport, transfer to your accommodation. Flights to be advised.

ROTORUA - located on a volcanic plateau, and formerly a spa town, Rotorua is most famous for its geothermal activity. Rotorua is the main place in New Zealand where aspects of Maori traditions can be seen, from wood carvings, and meeting houses, to a Hangi Dinner and Māori dances. Native and introduced tree species abound locally and combined with several picturesque lakes, Rotorua is a fascinating mix of culture and nature.

Day 14 - Tuesday, Mar.25/2025 -- Rotorua

Today, enjoy a full day sightseeing tour in Rotorua, including Wai-o-Tapu and Te Puia.

Rotorua City Sightseeing highlights: Lake Rotorua, Redwood Forest, and Government Gardens.

Wai-o-tapu Thermal Wonderland|

Admission into New Zealand's most colorful natural volcanic area. Thousands of years in the making but only 20 minutes' drive south of Rotorua. Nested with a natural bush setting, walks through this unique volcanic area take between 30 and 75 minutes. 26 key natural features including the world-famous, multi-colored Champagne Pool.

Te Puia|Te Po combo (Guided experience + Indigenous Evening)

Be guided through New Zealand Māori Arts & Crafts Institute, Rotowhio Pā, Kiwi Conservation Centre and Te Whakarewarewa geothermal valley including Pōhutu geyser with one of our shared tour departures.

Te Pō begins with our mouth-watering buffet with locally sourced cuisine and an authentic Māori twist in each dish. Following dinner, you will experience the exhilarating pōhiri (ceremonial welcome) in our beautifully carved meeting house, Te Aronui a Rua. Enjoy the beauty and power of traditional waiata (song), mōteatea (chants), poi and haka.

Then travel into the geothermal valley on our e-waka (36 seat electric passenger shuttle) for a hot chocolate upon our naturally heated rock-seating overlooking the dramatically lit Pōhutu Geyser.

Day 15 – Wednesday, Mar. 26/2025 -- Rotorua - Waitomo - Auckland

This morning you will travel through the King Country region which was at the centre of the New Zealand Wars in the 1860s to Waitomo Caves. See the amazing underground Glow Worm Grotto by boat and walk through the limestone caverns. Follow the meandering trail of the Waikato River, New Zealand's longest river, past the lush farmlands of the Waikato Region. As you journey over the Bombay Hills, the landscape changes from green, grassy meadowlands to the edge of suburbia.

Waitomo Glowworm Caves|Waitomo Glowworm Caves

Your guided tour will take you through over 250 metres of stunning underground scenery commencing with the impressive Cathedral. Your tour begins at the upper entrance of the cave and proceeds along a low narrow passage to the Tomo, a deep limestone shaft. Your experienced tour guide will deliver a highly informative commentary about the formations, sharing stories, cultural legends and the natural wonders of this living masterpiece and the history of the area. The highlight of your tour is an unrivalled boat trip through the spectacular Glowworm Grotto.

Marvel at Mother Nature's light display as you glide silently through the starry wonderland of the Glowworm Grotto. Meander underground along the Waitomo River and gaze in silence at the myriad of glow worm lights that make up the Glowworm Grotto. As you enter this galaxy of tiny living lights,

You'll immediately experience a serene ambience and be fascinated and intrigued by tiny glowworms that light your way. Duration: 45mins.

Travel to Auckland.

AUCKLAND / TĀMAKI MAKĀURAU - an exciting, sporting, and cultural city, sprawled on a narrow isthmus, between two harbours. The Waitemata and Manukau Harbours, are a main feature of the city, along with numerous volcanic cones such as Mount Eden and Rangitoto Island. The city's many beaches, marinas, and parks make it ideal for outdoor pursuits such as yachting, rugby, cricket or a day at the beach. The Auckland metropolitan area is New Zealand's biggest city, and the population mix of European, Maori, and Pacific Islander, make Auckland the largest Polynesian city in the World.

Auckland City sightseeing highlights: (Harbour Bridge, Waterfront, Mission Bay, Tamaki Drive, Savage Point, Parnell Rose Park and Village, Auckland Domain and Gardens and City centre).

SKYCITY Auckland - Sky Tower|Total Tower Experience - Sky Tower/Sky Deck Taller than the Eiffel Tower in Paris and the AMP Tower in Sydney, the iconic Auckland Sky Tower at 328m high is the focal point of the city and renowned for its breathtaking views taking in ancient volcanoes, sparkling sunlit harbours and beyond, excellent dining, interactive installations and adrenaline-pumping entertainment such as SkyJump, SkyWalk and SkySlide .

Entrance to the Sky Tower is through an underground tunnel located at the base of the tower. Access to the observation deck and to the level where the restaurants are located is via three elevators with a glass front wall, and one with a glass floor.
