Welcome to Lisbon, Portugal! Meeting and assistance at the airport. Enjoy a panoramic city tour en route to the hotel. Free afternoon. Check in and welcome dinner at our hotel – our home for 2 nights. (Lisbon time - 6 hours ahead of Toronto)

### Day 3: Sunday, 19 Oct./25 Sightseeing tour of Lisbon

Lisbon was the center of Europe's longest-lived overseas empire. Portugal's imperial ambitions date back to Prince Henry the Navigator's 15th-century discoveries in West Africa. A local guide leads us through the Portuguese capital: admire views of the city from Eduardo VII Park; drive past the Plaza del Marqués de Pombal and the Mouraria District; discover the city's maritime heritage at the Monument to the Discoveries and Tower of Belém; visit Jerónimos Church, built to honour voyagers; walk through Chiado Square to the Baixa District in the heart of the city.

Day 4: Monday, 20 Oct./25 Evora - Seville (PORTUGAL - SPAIN)

After breakfast, we checked out of the hotel. We travel (approx. 2 hours' drive) through the unspoiled countryside of Portugal, stopping at the UNESCO-listed city of Évora for a sightseeing tour with a local guide: view the Roman temple; visit the Church of St. Francis, known as "the Chapel of Bones"; continue to Seville, Spain (approx. 4 hours' drive); check in to our hotel for 2 nights. A special dinner & flamenco show awaits us tonight.

## Day 5: Tuesday, 21 Oct./25 Sightseeing tour of Seville

Today we uncover the beauty of Seville, the historic Andalusian capital, on a full-day, guided sightseeing tour: view the tiled pavilion of the Plaza de España; drive pass the whitewashed homes of Barrio de Santa Cruz; visit the Gothic Seville Cathedral - the third largest church in the world.

Day 6: Wednesday, 22 Oct./25 Via Cordoba to Granada

Breakfast and check out of our hotel. Our first stop will be the city of Cordoba (approx. 2 hours' drive from Seville). We explore the amazing Mezquita, a UNESCO World Heritage site that was built in the 8th century as a mosque, then transformed into a cathedral during the Christian Reconquista of 1236. Continue for (approx. 3 hours' drive) to the city of Granada, check into our hotel for 2 nights.

## Day 7: Thursday, 23 Oct./25 Sightseeing tour of the Alhambra

Today's guided tour of Granada includes the 14th-century Alhambra, the last stronghold of the Moorish sultans: admire the blend of Western art and Islamic design; stroll through its ornamented courtyards. Free afternoon in Granada.

Day 8: Friday, 24 Oct./25 Ferry to Tangier (SPAIN – MOROCCO)

Breakfast and check out of our hotel. From Granada, we travel (approx. 4 hours' drive) to Tarifa for a 2-hour ferry ride to Tangier, Morocco. (**Please note:** We will need to handle our own luggage on the ferry.) Arrival in Tangier. Transfer to our hotel for check-in and dinner. (Tangier time - 4 hours ahead of Toronto)

Day 9: Saturday, 25 Oct./25 Rabat

Sightseeing tour of Tangier / Transfer to




Rabat

The day begins with a guided tour of Tangier, a city celebrated by Western writers like Paul Bowles and William Burroughs. Explore the stately French plaza and Boulevard Pasteur; traverse the maze-like passageways through the medina. From Tangier, From Tangier, travel to Rabat, Morocco's capital city, for a tour with a local guide: explore the Roman ruins at Chellah Gardens; tour the white and green Mausoleum of Mohammed V, housing the tombs of the 20th century king and his two sons. View Hassan Tower, intended to be the world's largest mosque until construction halted in 1199CE. The Royal Palace provides a perfect photo stop. Walk through the Kasbah des Oudaias with its famous Andalusian gardens.

### Day 10: Sunday, 26 Oct./25

### **Transfer to Fez and Sightseeing tour**

After breakfast we will travel to Fez, upon arrival our local guide leads us on a full day tour of Fez, the spiritual and cultural center of Moroccan life. See the ornate brass doors of the Royal Palace and visit the Mellah Jewish Quarter. View the Bab Bou Jeloud, a blue-tiled gate that exemplifies the Moorish architectural style; attend a ceramics demonstration -- learn how the intricate and colorful art pieces are created; explore the UNESCO-listed old Medina on a walking tour through the colorful souks and tanneries; visit the Mausoleum of Moulay Idriss and a madrassa - a type of local school for both secular and religious studies.

Day 11: Monday, 27 Oct./25 Fez / Casablanca / Marrakesh

After breakfast make our way to Casablanca, Discover the highlights of seaside Casablanca – made famous by Hollywood. Pass through its ancient medina, the bustling heart of the city; visit the Hassan II Mosque, the largest in Morocco and the fashionable La Corniche waterfront area. Continue (approx. 3 hours' drive) to Marrakesh, a former imperial city.

**Day 12: Tuesday, 28 Oct./25**

Get a feel for Marrakesh, located to the north of the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. On our guided tour, we pass through the sophisticated Gueliz district: see the massive Koutoubia Mosque, with its 200 feet high minaret that dominates the city's skyline. Enter the UNESCO-listed Medina of Marrakesh to see the Bahia Palace, the Saadian Tombs, the mausoleum for the 16th century ruling princes. We stroll through one of the city's vibrant souks to see the many products being sold by the local vendors; visit the Djemaa el-Fna, a lively open-air market where musicians, snake charmers, and clowns perform. Enjoy a special evening in Marrakesh -- a 1001-night dinner & show.

Overnight Marrakesh Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 13: Wednesday, 29 Oct./25 Marrakesh / Madrid (MOROCCO TO SPAIN)

After breakfast and check out, we transfer to the airport for our flight to Madrid.

Welcome to Madrid, transfer to our hotel.

Explore the Spanish capital's beautiful architecture, lively squares, grand boulevards on today's guided sightseeing tour including a photo stop at the Royal Palace; viewing the Temple of Debord; the city's many squares, including Plaza de España and Plaza Mayor. Explore the Prado Museum, home to the works of Goya, Velásquez, and more.
